The Iris Residence is a new construction home in Boulder's Newlands neighborhood - elegant and craftsman-informed, designed to feel fresh and considered without skewing too personal. The lighting and hardware scope was an ideal creative exercise: finding fixtures that feel genuinely curated while speaking to a broad audience.

SCOPE OF WORK

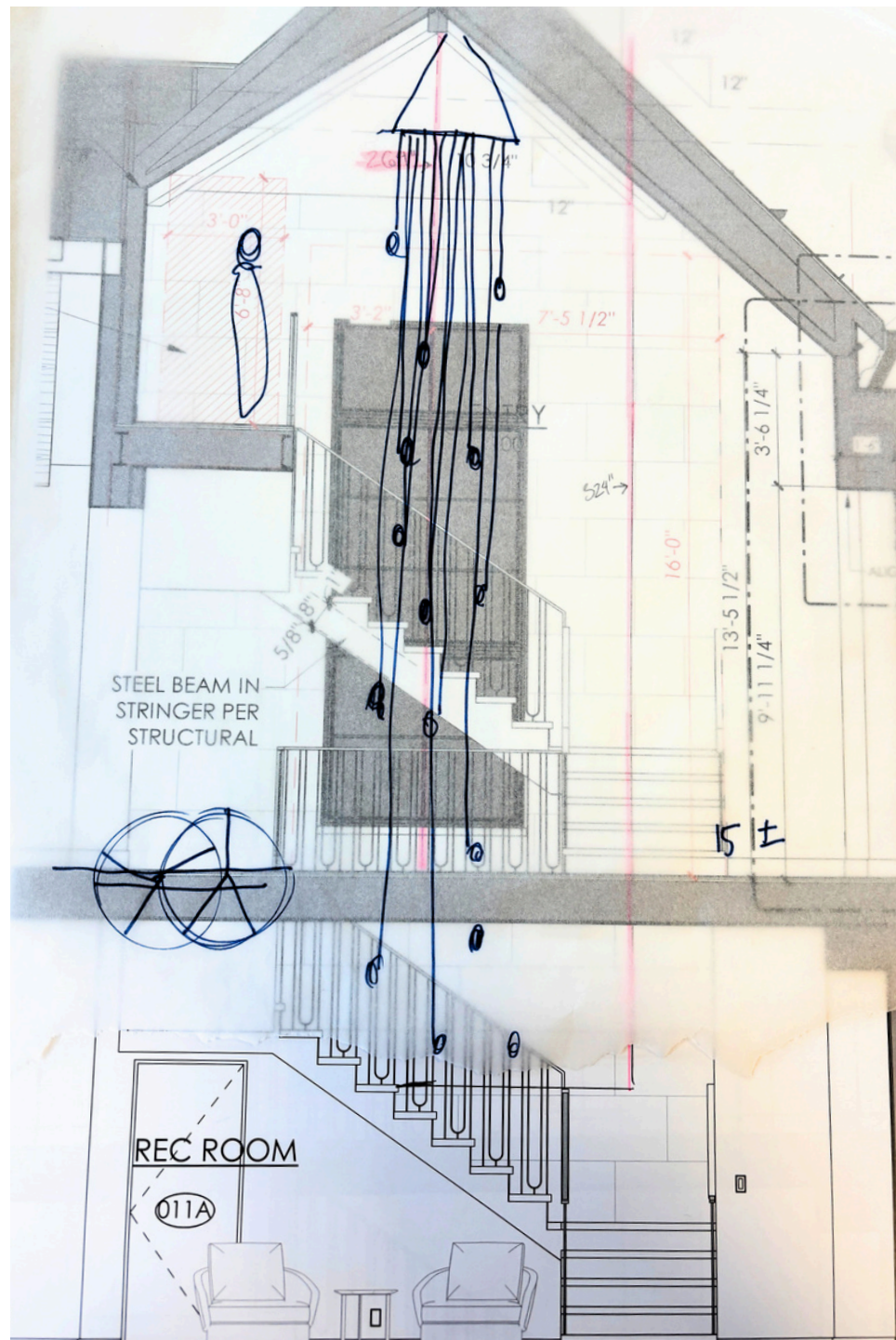

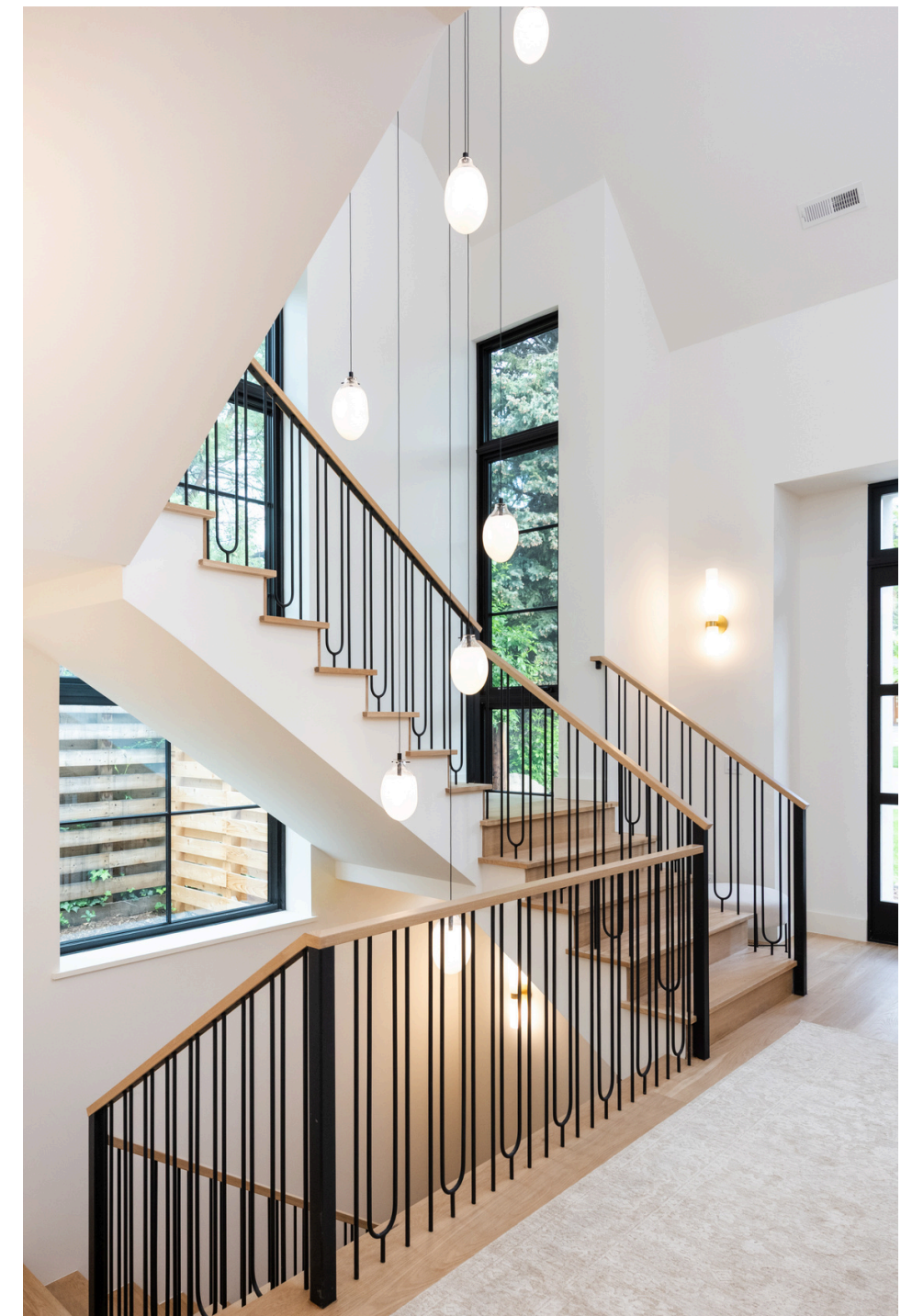

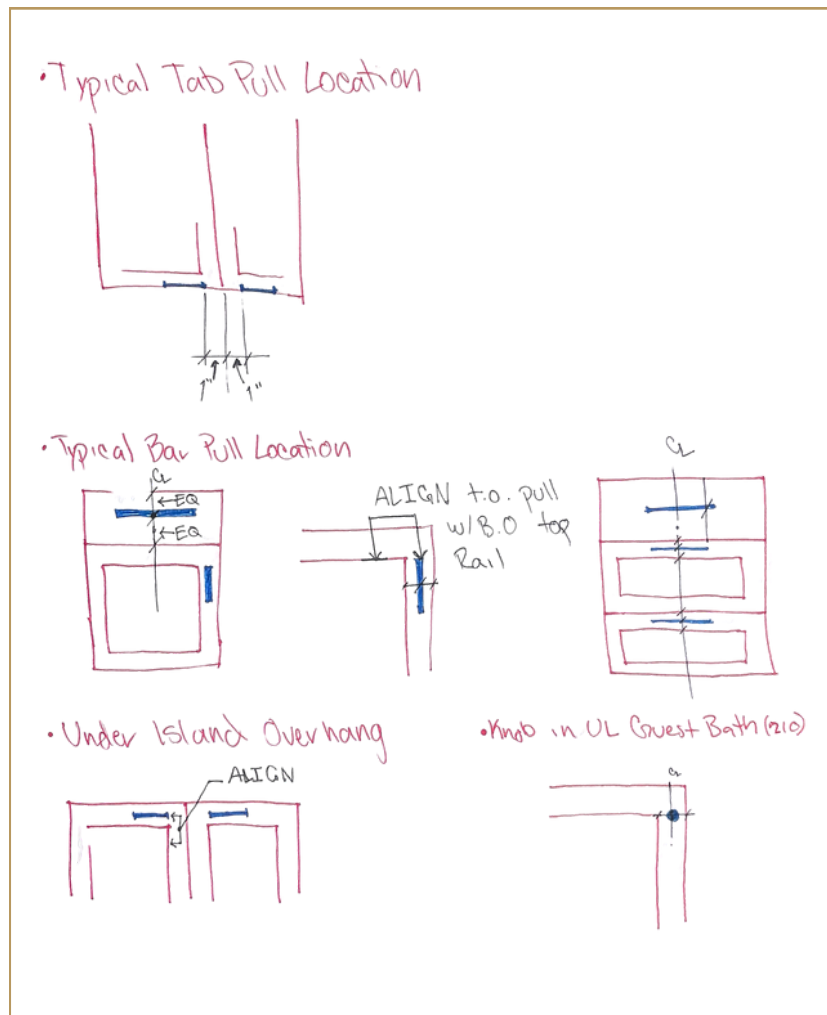

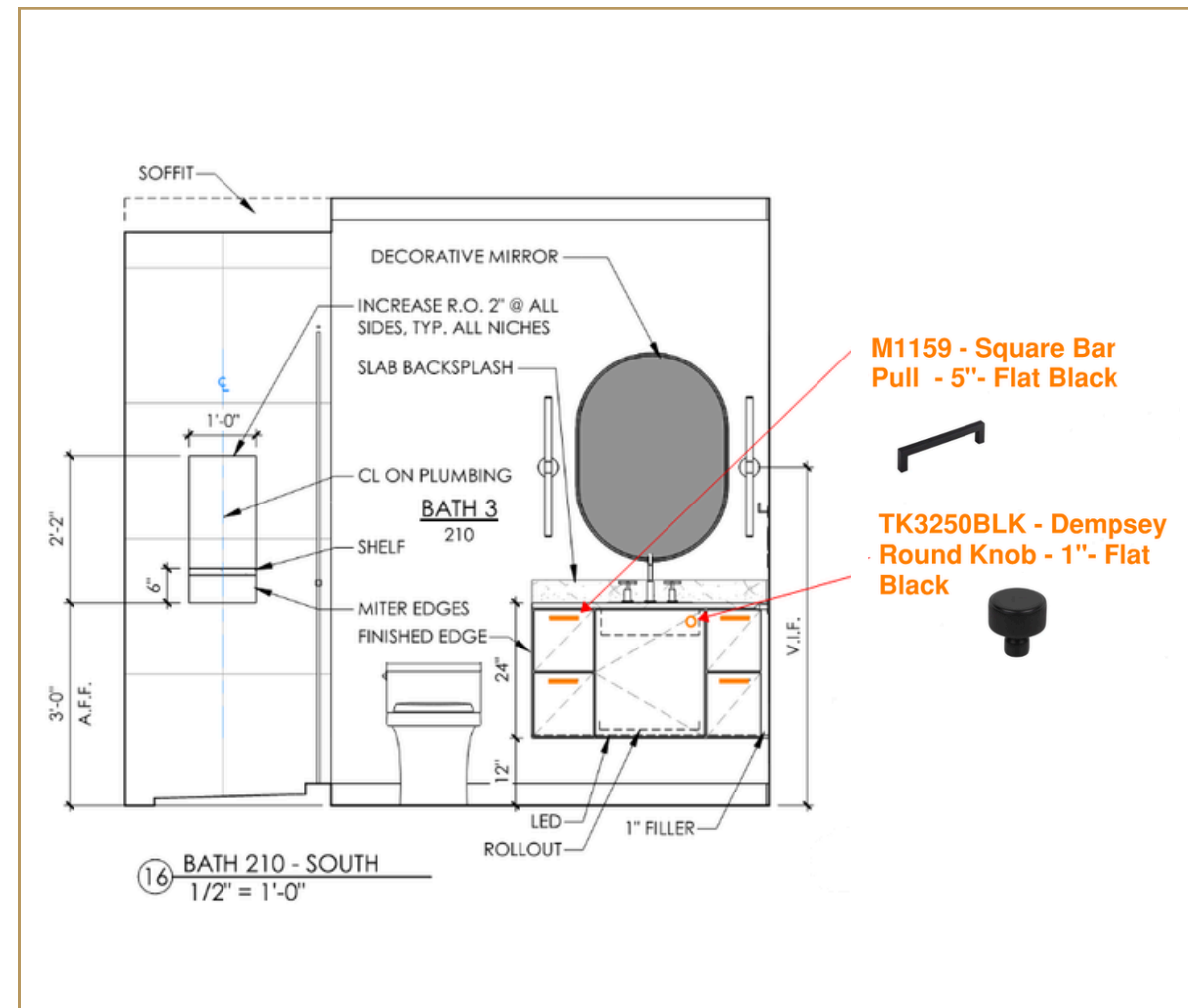

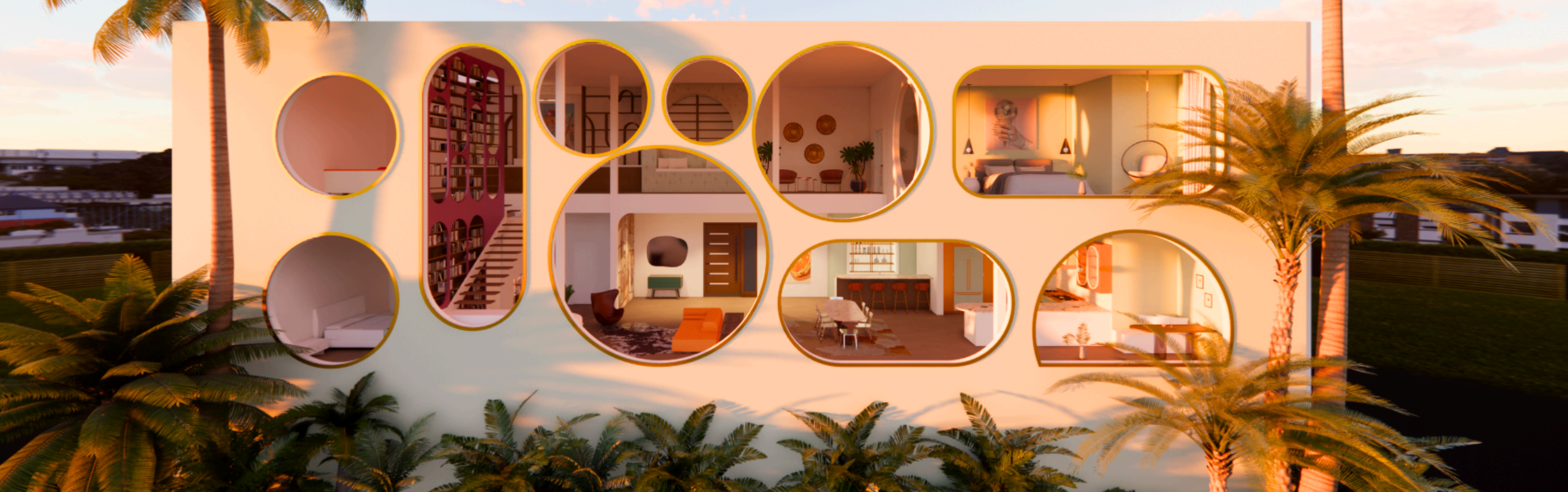

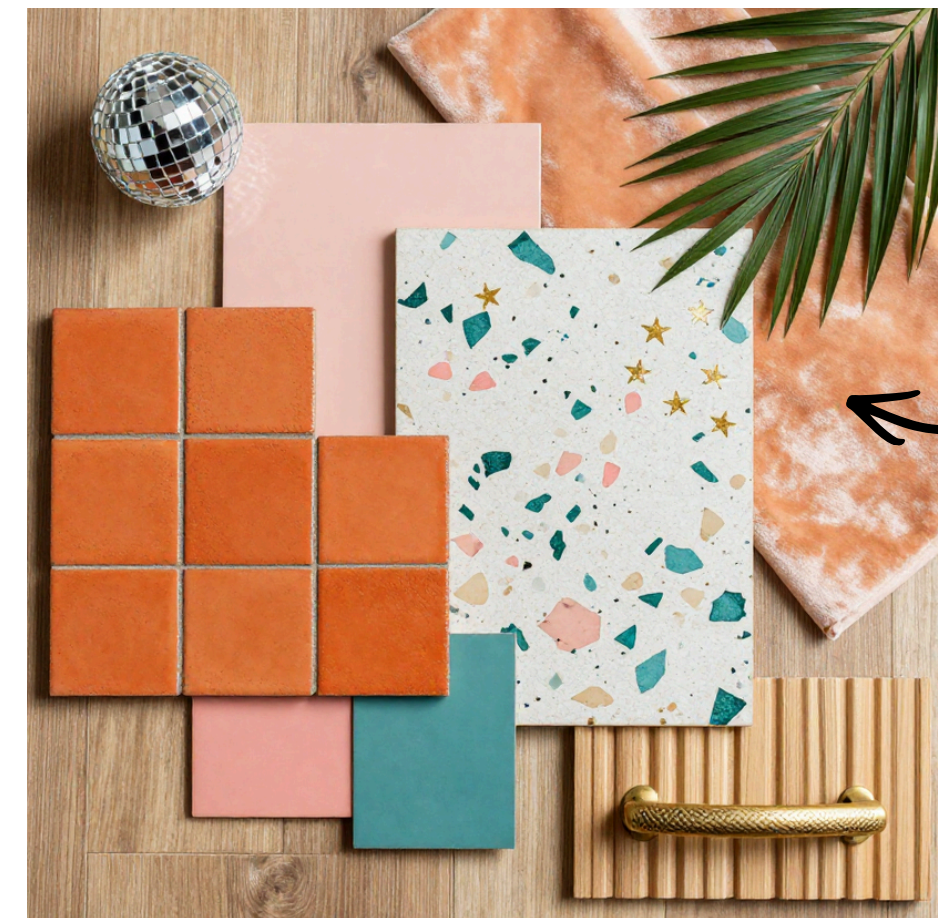
Studio 2 advanced the design process from concept through construction documentation, with an emphasis on fully resolved residential interiors across all phases - schematic design, material selection, lighting strategy, and technical drawing production. The Nova Loft is the result: a retro-futuristic two-level loft designed for a science fiction author, where playful curves, a mezzanine catwalk, and layered materiality create a space as imaginative as the stories written within it.

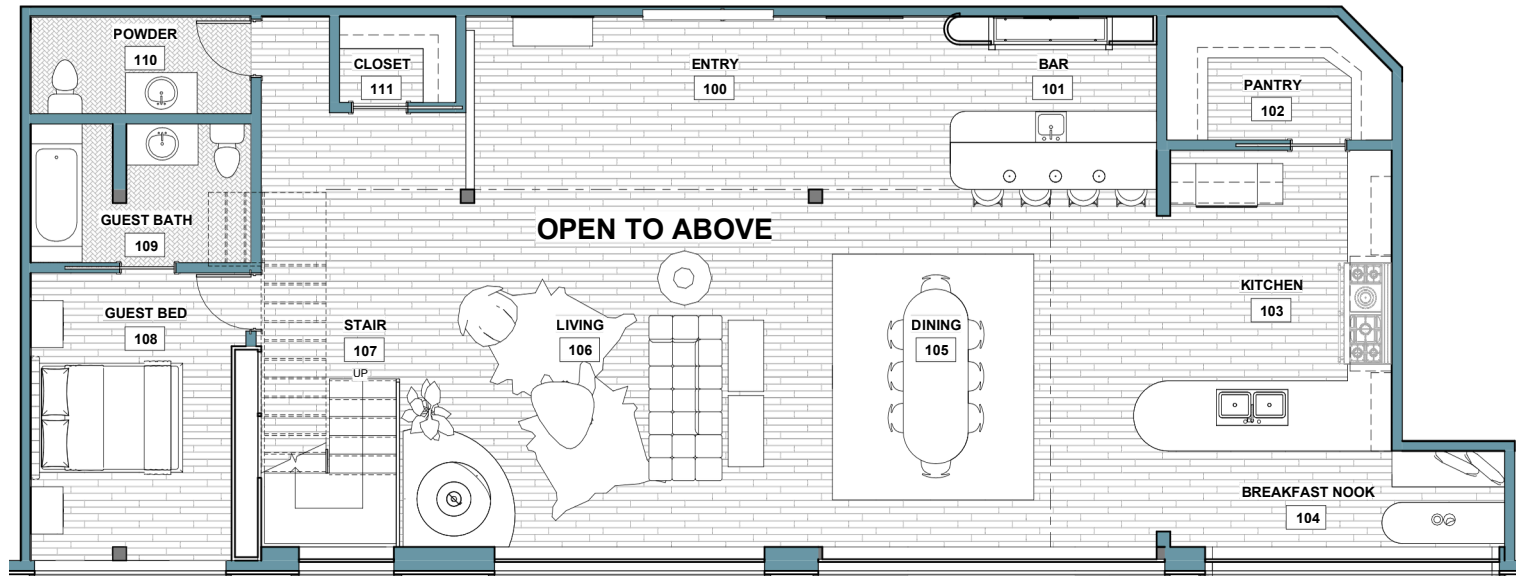

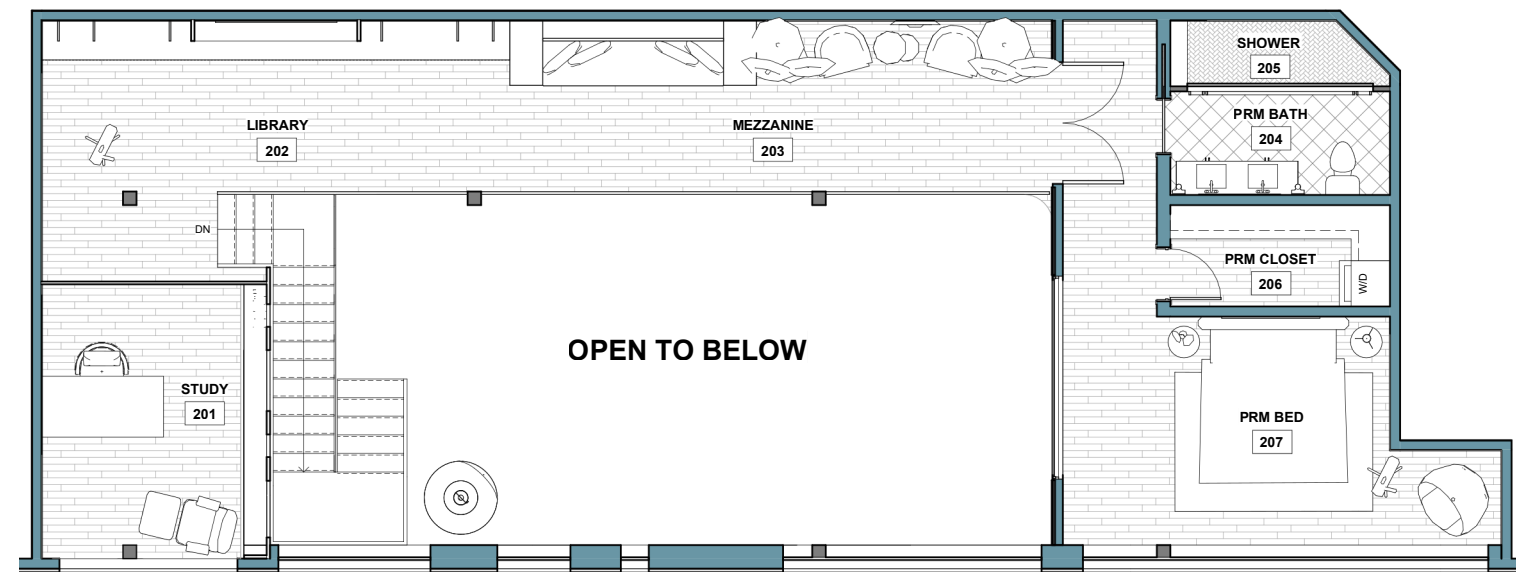

① FLOOR PLAN - MAIN LEVEL



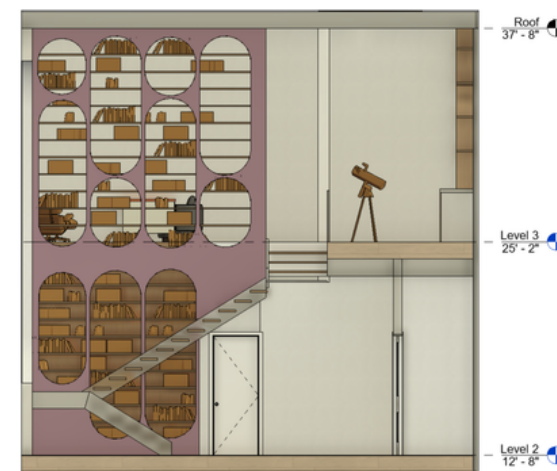
② FLOOR PLAN - UPPER LEVEL



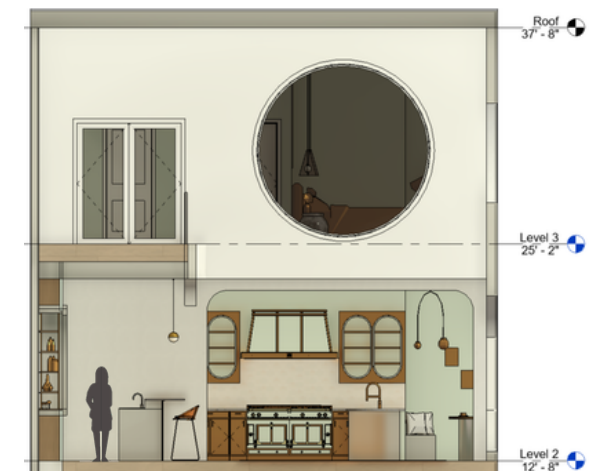
③ NORTH SECTION

PROJECT BRIEF

History of Interior Design examined design principles of ancient civilizations, tracing how culture, ritual, and material shaped the built environment.

The brief was to design an original interior in direct response to a studied artifact. The selected piece was the Cosmetic Box of the Royal Butler Kemeni, crafted in 1805 BCE during the Middle Kingdom for pharaoh Amenemhat IV.

KEMENI APOTHECARY DESIGN DEVELOPMENT

From an object's materials, function, and cultural context, an ancient Egyptian apothecary took shape. Designed as a destination for everyday indulgence, the space blended wellness and social connection within a refined environment grounded in the quiet luxury of the Middle Kingdom.

The cosmetic box itself informed every design decision. Its intentional construction translated into a space that is airy and minimalist yet luxurious in texture. Dark wood and creamy tones echoed in stone and linen, brass and copper fittings carried through into fixtures and detail.

Developed through AI-generated renderings and conceptual design language, the project highlights strengths in visual storytelling, thematic development, and experiential design.

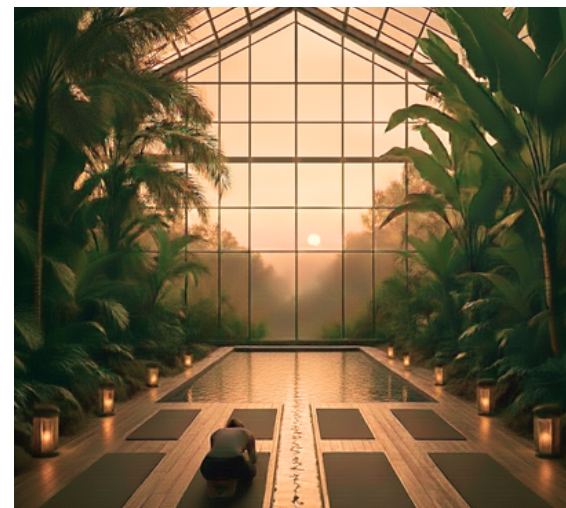
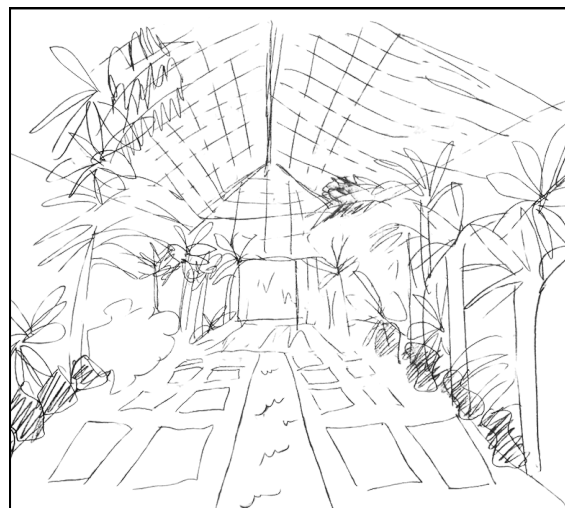

THE GRANITE HOTEL - DESIGN DEVELOPMENT

PROJECT BRIEF

Studio 1 introduced core space planning principles across residential and commercial typologies, from bubble diagram and block plans through to fully dimensioned, furnished floor plans meeting ADA and Universal Design requirements. The Granite Hotel emerged from this foundation as a conceptual luxury resort in the Brazilian jungle: a brutalist structure in tension with its lush surroundings, where raw concrete and tropical greenery define an atmosphere of exclusive, immersive hospitality.

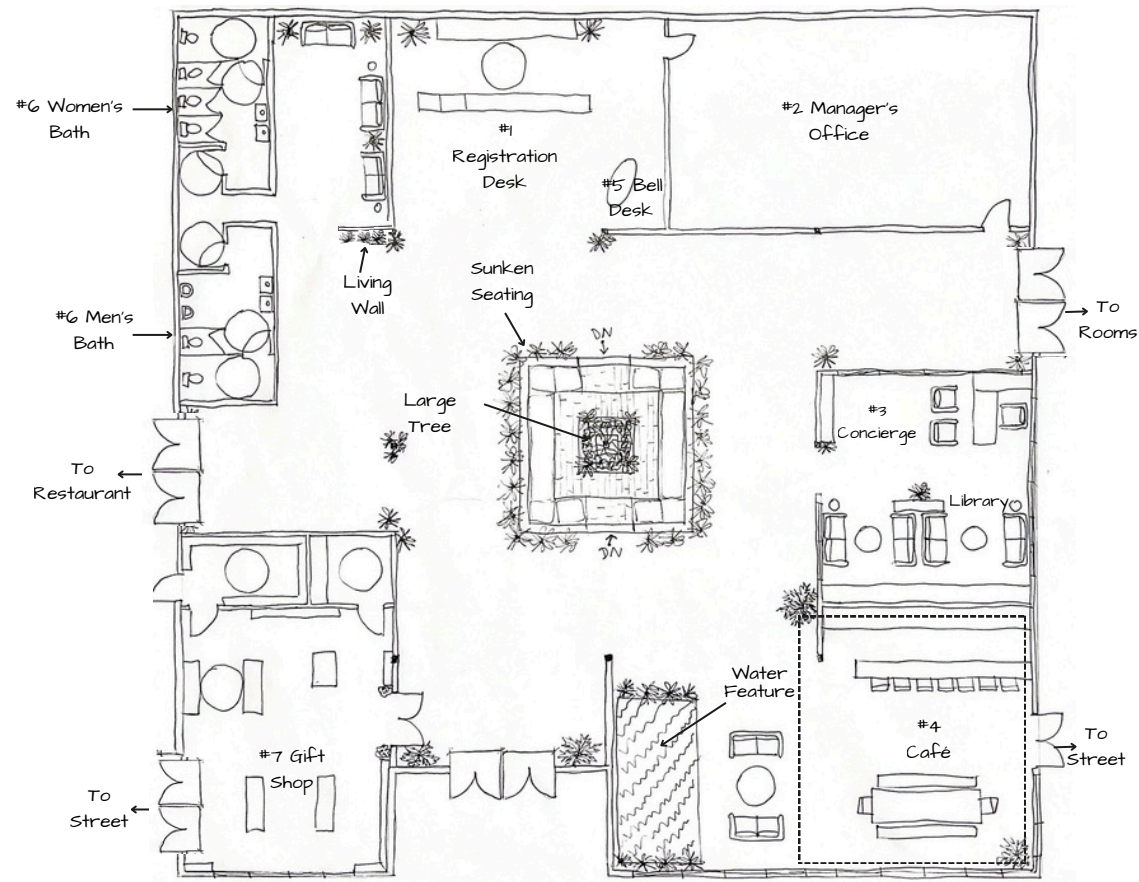

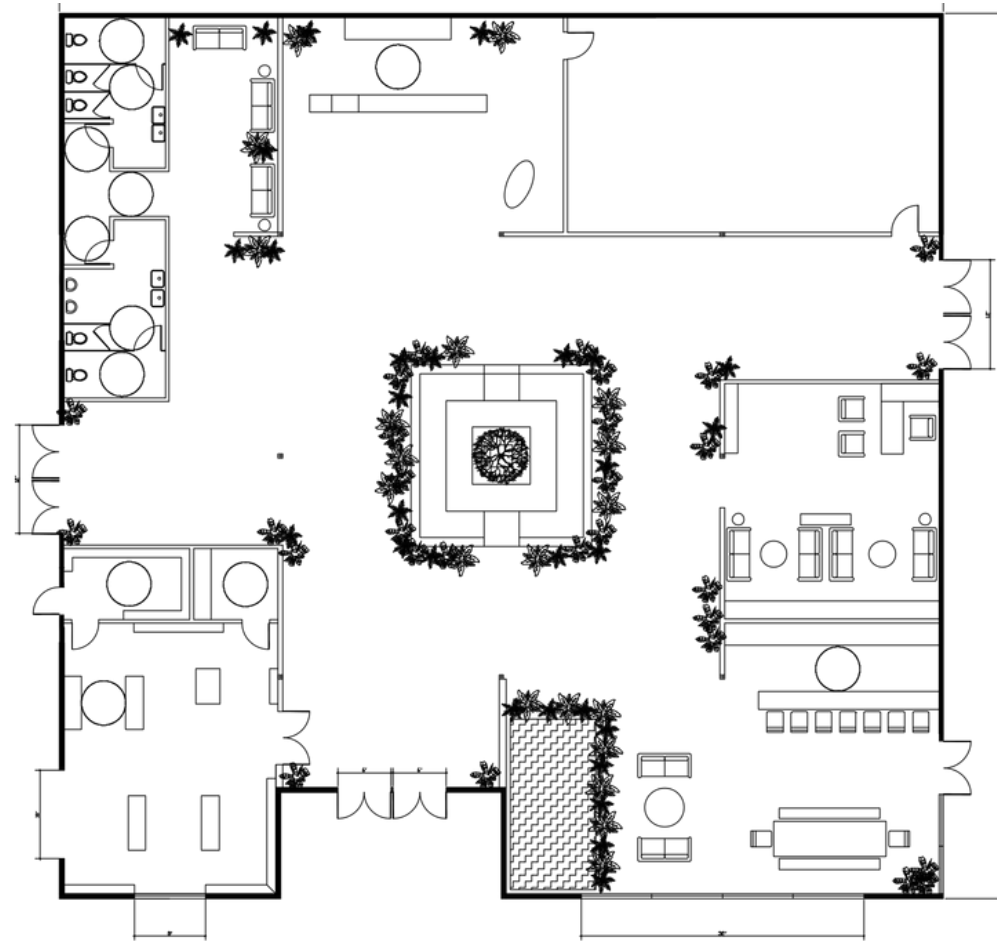
